Special Privacy Notice to Our California Resident Customers

The California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (“CCPA”) is a privacy statute that grants rights to California resident consumers and imposes obligations on certain businesses, including banks.

The CCPA grants California residents the right to stop the “sale” of their personal information by providing a “Do Not Sell My Personal Information” Notice to a business or bank. California’s definition of “sale” also captures the transfer of data between corporate affiliates (that is, companies that share common ownership) and other transfers that ordinarily may not be thought of as a “sale” in the traditional sense of the word.

Peoples Bank shares data with certain trusted business partners in order to process financial transactions, maintain accounts and offer other products and services to our customers, and to respond to court orders, legal investigations or report to credit bureaus.
